In the event DOSH has delegated its power to other authorities on the implementation of OSHA, it has a responsibility to ensure the power is effectively implemented by the agencies concerned.</p>
Implementation Plan (Status/Update)	<p>Implementation Plan Details</p> <p>DOSH will conduct occupational safety and health (OSH) audits on transportation sectors as stipulated under OSHA 1994.</p> <p>Up to date, DOSH has conducted more than 130 audits on transportation sectors (since 2009).</p>
Status of implementation, including - outcomes achieved.	<p>Desired Outcome (s)</p> <p>Every transportation company has comply with OSHA 1994 and implemented a good OSH Management System.</p> <p>Rationale</p> <p>OSH Audits on every sector of industry, including transportation sectors is one of the routine enforcement activities carried by DOSH over the years. Every year, plan is executed to identify and audit transportation companies. The plan is developed based on the number of companies which has been registered with DOSH. Frequency of audit is once a year, or depending</p>
