HELICOPTER CRASH AT SUBANG AIRPORT, SELANGOR

The Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) confirms that an Airbus Helicopter AS350 B3 had crashed at Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport, Subang, Selangor at 9.25am on Wednesday, 24th March 2021.

The helicopter, operated by Leopad Aviation Sdn Bhd, had departed Sungai Lembing, Pahang at 8.30am on a private flight to Subang via Maran, Temerloh, Karak and Batu Caves, with one pilot and four passengers on board.

Two people are reportedly injured and is currently receiving medical assistance while 3 others are in stable condition. The safety investigation will be conducted by the Air Accident Investigation Bureau under the Ministry of Transport Malaysia in accordance with Part XXVI Civil Aviation Regulations 2016.
