PRELIMINARY AIR ACCIDENT REPORT OF AIRCRAFT N28JV AT ELMINA

Today, the Ministry of Transport has received the Preliminary Report from the Air Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB) regarding the investigation on the air accident involving the N28JV aircraft near Elmina, Shah Alam, which occurred on August 17, 2023.

The Preliminary Report complies with the standards of Annex 13 to the Convention on International Civil Aviation (ICAO Annex 13), which requires the submission of a preliminary report within 30 days of an accident.

This report contains statements of facts and preliminary findings which have been determined up to the time of issue of the report. The Preliminary Report shall be regarded as tentative, and is subject to alteration or correction if additional evidence becomes available.

The Final Report of the investigation will be completed no later than August 2024, in accordance with the ICAO Annex 13, which allows for a 12-month period to finalise the document following the accident.

The Ministry of Transport expresses appreciation for the diligent efforts of the AAIB and is committed to enhancing aviation safety based on the bureau's findings.

The Ministry also conveys its deepest gratitude to the National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB) of the USA and the Transport Safety Investigation Bureau (TSIB) of Singapore for providing invaluable assistance in the AAIB investigation through their respective Accredited Representative and technical advisors, both in the country and abroad.

The accident involved a Beechcraft Model 390 Premier 1 aircraft that departed from Langkawi International Airport and crashed enroute to Subang Airport. This tragedy claimed 10 lives, including 8 passengers and crew on board the aircraft and 2 ground bystanders.

Once again, the Ministry of Transport expresses its deepest sympathy and offers condolences to the families of the victims.
