## **MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT MALAYSIA UPDATE TO FAMILIES**

### **MH370 SEARCH OPERATION (2025/2026)**

On 25 March 2025, the Government of Malaysia signed an agreement with Ocean Infinity to undertake seabed search operations to locate the wreckage of flight MH370 in a new area estimated at 15,000 square kilometres in the southern Indian Ocean, based on the “no find, no fee” principle.

Search operations under this agreement were conducted in two phases:

- Phase 1: 25–28 March 2025
- Phase 2: 31 December 2025 – 23 January 2026

In total, 28 operational search days were undertaken across both phases following the signing of the agreement, resulting in the survey of approximately 7,571 square kilometres of seabed within the defined search area.

Ocean Infinity has indicated that additional survey activities were undertaken within the broader search area before the formal signing of the agreement in March 2025, as part of efforts supporting the search operation.

Operations were periodically disrupted by weather and sea conditions. Phase 2 concluded on 23 January 2026.

As at the date of this update, the search activities undertaken have not yielded any findings that confirm the location of the aircraft wreckage.

The Government remains committed to keeping the families informed and will continue to provide updates as appropriate.
