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ASEAN PORTS & LOGISTICS 2026 OPENS IN KUALA LUMPUR

KUALA LUMPUR, 8 July 2026 – The ASEAN Ports & Logistics Exhibition and Conference 2026 was officially opened today by YB. Loke Siew Fook, Minister of Transport, Malaysia at Sofitel Kuala Lumpur Damansara. Held from 7 to 9 July 2026, the event is one of ASEAN's leading annual maritime and logistics conferences and exhibitions, bringing together industry leaders to discuss issues shaping the future of the maritime and logistics sector.
