## SIARAN MEDIA MENTERI PENGANGKUTAN MALAYSIA

### PATUH SOP BAGI PERJALANAN RENTAS NEGERI

Sepertimana pengumuman YAB Perdana Menteri, Dato' Sri Ismail Sabri Yaakob semalam, 10 Oktober 2021, aktiviti rentas negeri dibenarkan berkuatkuasa hari ini, 11 Oktober 2021 di seluruh negara.

Dalam masa sama, Keluarga Malaysia yang ingin ke luar negara juga kini tidak lagi perlu memohon 'My Travel Pass' sebagaimana yang diperlukan sebelum ini. Namun, pengembara yang baru pulang ke tanahair masih perlu kuarantin wajib sebagai usaha mengekang penularan wabak COVID-19.

Ini membuktikan Kerajaan amat memahami perasaan Keluarga Malaysia yang sekian lama tidak dapat pulang ke kampung halaman akibat COVID-19.

Sehubungan itu, Kementerian Pengangkutan Malaysia (MOT) ingin mengingatkan kepada operator-operator pengangkutan awam bagi kesemua sektor darat, udara dan maritim seperti pengusaha bas ekspres, rel, teksi, e-hailing, syarikat penerbangan, pengusaha feri dan kapal agar tidak leka serta sentiasa mematuhi Prosedur Operasi Standard (SOP) yang ditetapkan Kerajaan di bawah Pelan Pemulihan Negara (PPN).

Semua operator perlu memastikan setiap penumpang atau pengguna perkhidmatan pengangkutan awam menunjukkan sijil vaksinasi bagi membuktikan mereka telah lengkap divaksinasi sebagaimana yang dikehendaki dalam SOP bagi tujuan rentas negeri.

Pematuhan-pematuhan SOP lain seperti memakai pelitup separuh muka dan kerap mencuci tangan atau menggunakan cecair pembasmi kuman (*hand sanitizer*) juga perlu dipatuhi tanpa kompromi. Para pengguna pengangkutan awam turut digalakkan membuat ujian saringan COVID-19 sendiri sebelum memulakan perjalanan rentas negeri bagi melindungi diri sendiri, keluarga dan orang sekeliling.

Selain itu, MOT juga ingin mengucapkan setinggi penghargaan kepada petugas-petugas barisan hadapan negara yang bertungkus-lumus tanpa mengenal erti penat lelah sehingga kadar vaksinasi populasi dewasa rakyat Malaysia telah mencapai 90.02% atau 21,073,482 orang lengkap divaksinasi setakat 10 Oktober 2021. Terima kasih juga kepada seluruh anggota keselamatan yang bekerja siang malam menjaga keamanan dan keselamatan Keluarga Malaysia.

### **FOLLOW SOP DURING INTERSTATE TRAVEL**

As announced by Prime Minister Yang Amat Berhormat Dato' Sri Ismail Sabri Yaakob, interstate travel is now allowed beginning 11 October 2021 nationwide.

At the same time, Malaysians who need to travel overseas are no longer required to apply for MyTravelPass. However, returning travelers to Malaysia are still required to undergo mandatory quarantine as an effort to control the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Government understands that our Malaysian Family has long been unable to return to their hometowns due to the pandemic.

In this regard, the Ministry of Transport Malaysia (MOT) would like to remind public transport operators in all land, air and maritime sectors to avoid complacency and always adhere to the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) set by the Government under the National Recovery Plan (PPN).

All operators must ensure that every passenger or public transport user shows their vaccination certificate to prove that they have been fully vaccinated as required in the SOP for interstate travel.

Other SOP compliance such as wearing a face mask and frequent hand washing or using hand sanitizer must also be adhered to without compromise. Public transport users are also encouraged to take the COVID-19 self-screening test before embarking on an interstate journey to protect themselves, their families and those around them.
